Don't let them in.

Dear Resident,

Recently, there has been a number of burglaries in your area so I would like to inform you of what your local neighbourhood policing team and local partners are doing to keep you safe, particularly as the darker nights draw in.

If no light is on in your home, curtains are not drawn and no car is in the drive, it's an obvious sign to an opportunist burglar that nobody is at home. At this time of year it pays to secure your home more than ever. There are a number of simple and free ways to do this, all of which will help reduce the chance of your home becoming a target.

Your home shows the following insecurities:

Light it

- Dark or hidden entrances
- Poor lighting
- House in darkness, no light timers in use

Invest in a 24-hour segment timer for under £5. The timer can be used with a lamp, radio or TV to give the impression that someone's home. Remember to use an energy efficient light bulb.



Lock it

- Side gate unlocked
- No side gate/barrier
- Inadequate fencing (too low)
- Bins by side gate (act as stepping stones for the burglar)
- Bins not secured
- Things that can aid climbing not secured (ladders etc)
- Hedging/plant growth high – provides camouflage
- Items that can assist in breaking in not secured (garden tools etc)
- Car unlocked
- Window left open



List it

- Valuable items can easily be seen through window
- A car unlocked and items left on display
