

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SOULDERN PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 282, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Souldern Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Souldern Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Souldern extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	High Street	a point 133 metres southeast of its junction with Bovewell.
b)	Wharf Lane	a point 85 metres southwest of its junction with the unnamed unclassified road signed on site as Mill Lane. High Street.
