## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SOULDERN PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20\*\*

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 282, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Souldern Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 20\*\* and shall come into force on the day of 20\*\*.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Souldern Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2003 is hereby revoked.

## **SCHEDULE**

## 20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Souldern extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	High Street	a point 133 metres southeast of its junction with Bovewell.
b)	Wharf Lane	a point 85 metres southwest of its junction with <mark>the</mark> <del>unnamed unclassified road signed on site as Mill Lane</del> . High Street.
