## Re: Souldern Farm Lane, Fritwell – Carriageway Resurfacing

I am writing to inform you that Oxfordshire County Council will be undertaking carriageway maintenance and resurfacing work to Souldern Farm Lane in Fritwell between the access to Lower Souldern Grounds Farm and the junction with Souldern Road near Inkerman Cottage.

The works are programmed to start on **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022** and are expected to last for three consecutive days, finishing on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, subject to any bad weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances during construction.

Works will include ironwork adjustments and the resurfacing of the existing carriageway, following which all existing and legal road markings and lines will be reinstated.

## **Traffic Management**

To keep noise disruption to a minimum at night, the works will be carried out under three consecutive daytime full road closures from 0700-1900hrs. Souldern Farm Lane will be fully reopened outside of these hours. A fully signed diversion route will be put in place for the works duration.

A No Waiting enforcement comes into operation whilst works are undertaken along Souldern Farm Lane. It would be appreciated if all vehicles could avoid parking on the carriageway for the duration of the works, as this will impede the resurfacing and could delay any works.

Access to properties along Souldern Farm Lane will be affected by the works and restricted between the hours of 0700-1900, although we will endeavour to accommodate individual specific requirements in an emergency. We apologise unreservedly for any inconvenience this may cause.



Pedestrians and cyclists will be escorted or directed past the works by the team on site. However, there may be delays due to the nature of work.
