The parish council agrees that the land Mr Blunt is claiming is his, is not in fact his and cannot be registered as such. The parish council may consider registering the land as common land and take responsibility for maintaining the land. The logs preventing access and 'defining' the land in question should be removed and NO will draft a letter requesting Mr Blunt removes the logs.
